Diocesan messages from Bishop Patrick

Anniversary of the Abortion Act 1967: The Day for Life in 2017 falls on Sunday 18th June and I hope that each parish, chaplaincy and convent will organise a service of prayer and reflection on Saturday 17th July to pray for the dignity of human life from conception to natural death; I will lead such a vigil at a service of prayer in St Barnabas' Cathedral on 17th July. There will also be a vigil in St Barnabas' Cathedral on Friday 27th October, the fiftieth anniversary of the Act receiving the royal assent.

Closure of the Jubilee of Mercy: The doors of mercy in all our parishes and the holy doors in Mount St Bernard Abbey, Holy Cross Priory and the Briars, Crich will be closed on Sunday 13th November 2016; At Mass that Sunday, I would like each parish and chaplaincy to commission two people to represent them at the solemn closure of the Jubilee of Mercy, which will be celebrated on Sunday 20th November 2016, the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe at 6.00 pm in St Barnabas' Cathedral; everyone is very welcome to this Mass.

Legacy of the Jubilee Year of Mercy: I would also like each parish, school, religious house and chaplaincy to think about the legacy of the Jubilee of Mercy, and what can be done practically to enable us to continue to live the spiritual and corporal works of mercy, and I would like each deanery to discuss the legacy at the next deanery meeting, if they have not already done so.
